

RED THREAD FUNGUS (Mid Spring)

YOUR LAWN HAS RED THREAD FUNGUS

Red thread appears as reddish irregular patches in mid spring. The fungus is caused by damp and drizzly weather in the 60° to 70° degree temperature range. Often as dry warmer weather approaches red thread will grow out on its own with no permanent damage.

Occasionally supplemental feeding of fertilizer may be needed and on rare occasions a fungicide must be applied. Please follow your **GREENTURF WATER GUIDE** and avoid afternoon and evening waterings. If you have any questions, please call and we will be glad to advise you accordingly.
